Steve replied saying we should try just a few trees first to see what happens! Mike volunteered to look into spiral protectors re use on fruit trees and will report to the next monthly meeting.

Steve wondered if the increased use of contactless transactions might reduce our donation from the Co-op because not as many people would use their Co-op card. Brian explained that the donation is based largely on total sales, and not just on those who use the Co-op card tied to us, so should have little effect.

Tina brought the meeting to a close and thanked all present at the meeting and all those who are back working in the orchard again. In particular she expressed her thanks to: Steve & Fiona for work on the web site and social media; Neil Oxley of the Woodland Trust for his help and support; Our local councillors for their continued support; Cheshire constabulary for keeping an eye on the orchard; Brian for organising the meeting by Zoom.
